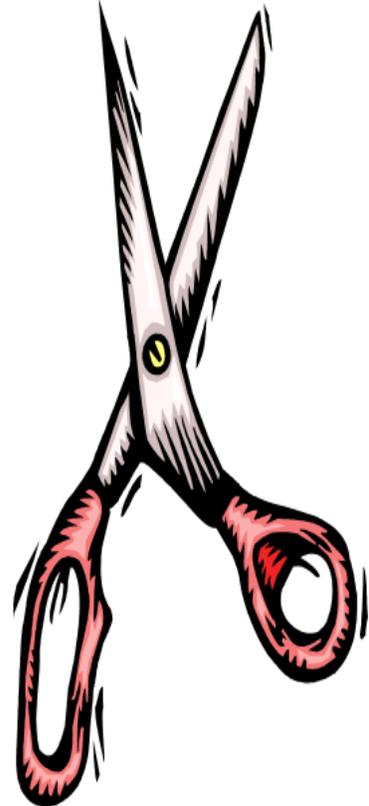

**Submittal Location, Deadline and Bid Opening**

Sealed bids must be delivered to 302 W. Reynolds Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Plant City, Florida 33563. The submittal deadline is **Thursday, December 29, 2016, prior to 2:00 PM**, after which the bids will be opened and the names of each bidder will be announced.

**Questions**

Procurement Manager, Buddy Storey is the **only** staff designated and authorized to answer questions about this bid. Bidders may rely only on written responses or interpretations from the Procurement Manager. Verbal and/or written responses given by other City staff in response to bidder questions shall not be binding on the City. The City will recognize written addenda issued by the Procurement Manager as the only legitimate method of responding to questions about this bid or the project described within this bid.

## **SECTION 1 – BIDDER INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Submittal Location and Deadline. Bids must be submitted to the City of Plant City Procurement Division, 302 W. Reynolds Street, 3<sup>rd</sup>. Floor, Plant City, Florida 33563 by **Thursday, December 29, 2016, at 2:00 PM.** Bids will be time stamped upon receipt. **Bids submitted by fax, e-mail, or telephone will not be accepted. Late bids shall not be accepted.**
2. Submittal Envelope. **Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope or box clearly marked "IFB 17-012GS-ME Fire Extinguisher Services".** Bidder shall write its name on the outside of the envelope. (Bid Label provided herein)
3. Valid Term. Bids shall be valid for no less than 60 days from the submittal deadline.
4. Rejection. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids at any time and for any reason. Bids submitted after the deadline shall be rejected. Bids submitted in an unsealed or incorrectly marked envelope or box shall be rejected. Fax, e-mail, or telephone bids shall be rejected. Bids which are incomplete, unbalanced, conditional, obscure, or which contain terms or additions not called for, alterations or irregularities of any kind, or which do not comply with the Contract Documents may be rejected at the at the sole discretion of the City.
5. **ITEMS THAT MUST BE INCLUDED WITH BID:**
  - a. **Completed Bid Response Form**
  - b. **Evidence that the bidder is qualified to transact business in the State of Florida.**
  - c. **Class A and Class D License issued by the State of Florida Fire Marshall.**
  - d. **Current "ACORD" insurance certificate with at least \$1,000,000 in coverage per incident including worker's comp certificate or a photocopy of state certificate of exemption from Worker's Compensation.**
  - e. **Bidder references using forms under Bidder's Qualification and References**
  - f. **Completed form "SWORN STATEMENT UNDER SECTION 287.133(3)(A), FLORIDA STATUTES, ON PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES."**
  - g. **Non-Collusion Affidavit**

6. Response Form. Bids shall be made only on the form included in this packet (Section 6 Bid Form). Bid forms shall be signed by the owner or other authorized individual.
7. Number of Copies. Bids shall be submitted in the following formats
  - a. Two (2) paper copies of all required forms and documents, **and**;
  - b. One electronic copy of all required forms and documents. (PDF on a CD or Thumb Drive)
8. Completeness. The City may reject bids that are incomplete, conditional, deficient in any way, or which contain unsolicited additions/alterations.
9. Review Documents. Bidders must review all specifications and Contract Documents related to this bid and project. Failure to review all specifications, forms, Contracts, addenda, or other documents shall not relieve a bidder from any obligations contained in this bid or a subsequent Contract with the City.
10. Fill-In Required Forms & Seal Envelope. Bidders must accurately and completely fill-in the bid form included in this packet (see "Section 2 - Bid Submittals"). Bidder shall submit all documents listed in "Section 2. Bid Submittals" and elsewhere in this Invitation for Bids. Authorized signatures must be included on forms/documents. Incomplete or missing forms/documents may result in rejection of the bid.
11. Certification. Submittal of a bid shall be deemed as certification that a bidder has fully considered all factors associated with this Invitation for Bids, including any addenda.
12. Project Owner. The City of Plant City, Florida owns this project. The City Manager or designee is the City's authorized representative on this project.
13. Verification of Bidder's Capability. The City will verify Bidder's ability to complete the work specified in this bid. Verification may include evaluating a bidders:
  - a. Financial resources.
  - b. Licensure and certifications.
  - c. Background & references.

14. Award. City personnel will evaluate the bids. Determination of the lowest responsive and responsible bid will be made on the basis of the price submitted.

The City may award a Contract based on bid responses received from bidders without further discussion of such bids with the selected bidder. Therefore, bids should be submitted based on the most favorable terms available.

Bids that are not greater than \$50,000.00 may be awarded by the City Manager. The City Commission makes the final decision regarding award or rejection of bids that are greater than \$50,000.00.

15. Interim Extension. After all renewal options have been exercised, and it is determined that interim performance is required to allow for the solicitation and award of a new contract, the City may unilaterally extend the contract for a maximum period of six months. Current pricing, delivery and all other terms and conditions of the contract shall apply during this period.

16. Local Preference. The City has adopted a local preference policy (Section 2-151, Plant City Code). As part of this Invitation for Bids, the local preference policy provides qualifying bidders with an amount not to exceed 1½ percent of the lowest bid, provided that the cost differential from the lowest bid shall not exceed \$2,500. Non-qualifying bidders will not receive the 1½ percent. A bidder qualifies for a local preference if it meets all of the following:

- a. Paid its applicable City business tax for the current year in which this Invitation for Bids is issued. Bidders that request local preference must include in their submittal packets a copy of the receipt proving payment of the City's business tax.
- b. Obtained a license issued by the State of Florida allowing it to engage in the business of providing the services requested in this Invitation for Bids.
- c. Maintains a physical office located within the city limits of Plant City. The office must be staffed by at least one full-time equivalent employee, and must have been established at least six months before the submittal deadline. Post Office boxes are not verifiable and will not be accepted as proof of a physical office location.
- d. A bidder that does not meet the criteria above will not receive 1½ percent calculated to the bid price submitted.

17. Waiver of Irregularities. The City may waive informalities or irregularities that in the City's opinion do not materially affect a bid.
18. Protest procedure. Any bidder or proposer who is allegedly aggrieved in connection with the issuance of the Procurement Manager's recommendation and intent to make a competitive award of a contract may protest to the City Manager in accordance with the City Code, Sec. 2-152. Protest Procedure.
19. Notice of Award. Upon review of the bids and when a determination has been made as to the lowest responsive and responsible bid, the Procurement Manager will issue a Notice of Intent to Award to the selected bidder. This notice shall be posted to the City's website and sent to the recommended bidder with copies to all bidders.
20. Notice to Proceed. Following Contract signing by the City, the Procurement Manager will issue a formal "Notice to Proceed" in writing to the selected vendor.
21. Revocation of Award. If the City discovers that the Contractor has misrepresented anything in their bid or that the Contractor – in the City's opinion – is no longer reasonably capable of performing the work as bid, then the City may revoke the award at any time **before** issuing the formal Notice to Proceed. The Procurement Manager will issue the revocation in writing.
22. Bid Interpretations. The City has the right to define and interpret bid terms, specifications, and conditions.
23. Changes or Modifications. The City may at any time make changes within the general scope of the contract in any of the following areas:
  - a. Time of Performance (i.e., hours of the day, days of the week, etc.).
  - b. Location of performance of the services.
  - c. Quantities to be ordered.

The Contractor shall not commence the performance of additional work or other changes not covered by this contract without an executed notice to proceed or purchase order issued by the City. If the Contractor performs additional work beyond the specific requirements of this contract without an executed change order, it shall be at the Contractor's own risk. The City assumes no responsibility for any additional costs for work not specifically authorized by an executed change order.

24. Indefinite Quantity. The quantities of goods and services specified herein are

estimates only and are not purchased by the resulting contract. Delivery or performance shall be as authorized by orders in accordance with the terms of the resulting contract. The City may issue orders requiring delivery to multiple destinations or performance at multiple locations.

25. Contract Documents. The Contract attached hereto is the Contract required by the City to award the project described in this bid. It is the Bidder's responsibility to review and understand the Contract. If the Bidder requires any modifications or additional terms and conditions to the Contract, the Bidder shall detail the desired changes on a separate page clearly titled "Additional Terms/Modifications". That page then must be attached to the bid response form and submitted as part of the bidder's proposal. **Contract modification requests after the Bidder's bid has been submitted shall not be considered.**

26. Sworn Statement on Public Entity Crimes. A person or affiliate as defined in Section 287.133, Florida Statutes, who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid, proposal, or reply on a Contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity; may not submit a bid, proposal, or reply on a Contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work; may not submit bids, proposals, or replies on leases of real property to a public entity; may not be awarded or perform work as a Contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a Contract with any public entity; and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of \$25,000 for a period of 36 months following the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

Bidders must fill out and sign the form titled "SWORN STATEMENT UNDER SECTION 287.133(3)(A), FLORIDA STATUTES, ON PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES." Failure to do so may disqualify the bid.

27. Other Forms & Documents. Bidders are responsible for reviewing and understanding all plans, photos, specifications, forms or other documents associated with the project described in this bid. Submittal of a bid shall serve as bidder's acknowledgement that it has reviewed and understood all such documents.

28. Indemnification. Section 1-15, Plant City Code, prohibits the City from indemnifying other parties to an agreement. Therefore, the City cannot indemnify bidders.

29. All-Inclusive Cost. The bid shall include all expenses necessary to complete the project or provide the services described in this Invitation for Bids. If selected by the City, the Bidder must pay applicable sales tax on any goods or services it purchases. The City is exempt from paying federal and state taxes, including sales tax. The City's sales tax exemption is not assignable and cannot be applied toward items the Contractor purchases, regardless of whether Contractor transfers those items to the City.
30. Bid Preparation & Submittal Expenses. The City shall not be responsible for any expense incurred by a bidder in reviewing, evaluating, preparing, or submitting a bid. Bidders are solely responsible for the entire expense of responding to this bid.
31. Legal Requirements. Bidders are required to comply with all provisions of federal, state, county and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations that are applicable to the services being solicited in this bid. A bidder's lack of knowledge shall in no way be a cause for relief from responsibility, nor shall it constitute a cognizable defense against the legal effects thereof.

Submittal of a bid shall constitute the bidder's affirmation that they are familiar with and shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations which affect those engaged or employed in the provision of such services, or equipment used in the provision of such services, or which in any way affects the conduct of the provision of such services. No plea of misunderstanding shall be considered on account of the bidder's ignorance thereof. If a bidder believes provisions in the bid documents are contrary to or inconsistent with any law, ordinance, or regulation, then the Bidder shall promptly report those provisions in writing to the City.

32. Public Records. Bidders understand that Florida has a broad public records law, and that documents in the possession of the City can only be maintained confidential to the extent allowed under the Florida Public Records Act, Florida Statute 119.
33. Cooperative Procurement Agreement. The City of Plant City is a member of the Government Procurement Council of Hillsborough County in accordance with Chapter 69-1119, Laws of Florida. It is hereby made a part of this Invitation to Bid that the submission of any bid in response to this request shall constitute a bid made under the same conditions for the Contract price as this bid to all public entities in Hillsborough County.

Successful Vendor will be required to make every effort possible to schedule inspections on as many buildings as possible per trip. 1. Award will be made by individual bid item or overall low of bid items 1, 2, 3 and 4 whichever is in the best interest of the City, and qualifications. Bidders must provide all requested information for the bid to be considered responsive. All bid items that are part of the basis of award should be bid at a fair and reasonable price. Failure to do so may cause the bid to be non-responsive. The Procurement Manager reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or waive any minor irregularities in the bids received, whichever would be in the best interest of the City.
2. **PERFORMANCE OF WORK:** The work required under this bid shall be performed by the entity submitting the bid.
3. The period of performance for this bid is from date of award through January 14, 2018. The bid will automatically renew for four (4) one (1) year periods, unless otherwise terminated.
4. All prices bid shall remain unchanged during the period of performance.

**5. QUALIFICATION OF VENDORS**

- a. The vendor performing services for the City under the terms of this bid shall have a Class A and Class D License issued by the State of Florida Fire Marshall. The vendor shall furnish the City with a copy of this license upon notification that they have been awarded this bid. The vendor shall also furnish proof that current permits have been issued to each of their employees who shall perform services for the City under the terms of this bid. These permits, issued by the State Fire Marshall, shall be required for each service technician.
- b. Vendor shall submit a reference list of at least three (3) projects similar in scope the vendor has completed in the last five (5) years. The list shall include: the project description; project address; current contact person, telephone number; and e-mail address. References must be submitted with the bid. Failure to submit reference with bid will be considered non-responsive.
- c. All of the successful vendor's employees that will be associated with this bid must pass the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) fingerprinting back ground check before any work can commence. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of the award.
- d. Vendor facilities, where high pressure hydrostatic testing of the extinguishers is performed, shall be approved by the Florida Bureau of Explosives. Upon notification, the vendor shall furnish the City with the approval number issued by the Bureau of Explosives or a copy of the approval letter from the Bureau.
- e. The vendor performing services for the City must have a computer program in place to establish a cycle for service at each job site when due per the list from

General Services. An estimated count of extinguishers throughout the City is as per the Location Schedule attached.

7. **TYPES OF SERVICES:** The general types of servicing to be required of the vendor will include inspecting, testing, recharging, repairing, cleaning, installing and labeling of fire extinguishers, fire hood suppression systems and fire hoses as required. Work is to be performed at various City locations throughout Plant City. Services to be performed by the vendor shall be in accordance with these specifications
8. Inspection cost shall include all materials to bring extinguishers up to NFPA codes and compliance. This would include but not be limited to all tags, labels, seals, pull pins, handles, rivets, and all external parts.
9. Bid Item #4 is a per trip charge. Per trip charge is defined as per day. Successful vendor may not charge a trip charge for every location visited. Successful vendor shall schedule as many locations as possible per day to help reduce cost.
10. Bid Item #5 is a percentage discount to be extended to the City for any additional services needed from the Successful Vendor's published prices at the time of award. Additional services will include but not be limited to: fire hood cleaning, suppression tank replacement, new extinguishers. Published prices by vendor must be submitted with the vendor's bid package. if the bid is extended, the Successful Vendor will provide the current published prices to be used for the term of the extension. The City reserves the right to purchase additional services from other vendors if it is in the best interest of the City to do so.

### **Scope of Services:**

1. The vendor shall inspect and perform required service on all fire extinguisher systems for various departments/divisions in accordance with the schedule stated on the Bid Sheets. All services performed under the terms of this bid shall comply with the regulations of the State of Florida, State Fire Marshall, as they pertain to fire extinguishers. Guidelines established by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) shall be followed during the inspection. Automatic extinguisher systems shall be inspected and/or serviced on a six (6) month (semi-annual) schedule. Fusible links shall be replaced once every six (6) months. The links must bear the current date. Vendor must be able to provide cleaning services to all extinguishing hood systems during the award of bid. Hood cleaning will be on an as needed basis.
2. At the time of the inspection, the vendor shall recharge all fire extinguishers not meeting minimum charge requirements. The vendor shall also ensure that all fire extinguishers are of the proper rating; and that they are properly installed and marked, as recommended by the NFPA and OSHA. The vendor shall furnish a durable tag or label for each extinguisher showing the required servicing data, including date of the annual inspection, if one is not already attached. Cost of tag or label shall be included in the inspection and/or service charges and shall not be charged separately.
3. If an extinguisher is damaged, corroded or otherwise unusable at the time of inspection or at any other time during the period of the contract, it shall be withdrawn from service; and the vendor shall test, recharge and/or replace the extinguisher as soon as possible. See Paragraph "4" below for details regarding withdrawal of fire extinguishers from service.
4. When it is necessary to remove a fire extinguisher for servicing, the vendor shall loan a fire extinguisher of equal size at no cost to the City until repairs are made.
5. If an existing fire extinguisher is beyond servicing and if the vendor and General Services Manager both agree that it should be replaced or that there should be additional fire extinguishers installed, the vendor shall obtain a written request from the General Services Manager. The percent discount shall apply to all replacement extinguishers. The City reserves the right to purchase extinguishers from other vendors if it is in the best interest of the City to do so.
6. The vendor shall be responsible for responding to routine service calls within seven (7) days without charge. The vendor shall also be responsible for responding to emergency calls within 24 hours at no additional cost to the City. Any additional charges not covered under the terms of this contract must be approved in writing by the General Services Manager prior to work being performed.

7. The vendor shall maintain records which identify fire extinguishers recharged or pressure tested during the period of this agreement, as required by the State Fire Marshall and NFPA regulations. It shall be the responsibility of the vendor to make follow-up calls as often as required to perform their service.
8. The charges for fire extinguisher inspections, in conjunction with a charge for recharging fire extinguishers, will not be authorized.
9. Invoices for services performed on buildings in Attachment "A" shall be submitted to: City of Plant City, P.O. Box C, Plant City, FL 33564. Invoices must be submitted within thirty (30) days after services are provided. ALL INVOICES MUST INCLUDE DEPARTMENT LOCATION FOR EACH CHARGE AND MUST BE LOCATION SPECIFIC, ONE LOCATION PER INVOICE.
10. Successful Vendor will be responsible for billing the correct City Division for any work performed under this bid. User divisions may request that vehicle extinguishers be replaced and the Successful Vendor is responsible for all billing information including: Division name, contact name and billing address. The City will not be responsible for any work or invoicing requested by other City Divisions.
11. Monthly Fire Extinguisher Inspection - Attachment "A" is a list of the various locations of fire extinguishers that must be serviced. The successful vendor shall service the extinguishers at the location and time prescribed. Any changes or deviations must be approved by the General Services Manager.
12. A complete inspection of all fire extinguisher systems, including ABC & BC Dry Chemical, foam, CO2, automatic hood systems and Halotron shall be required at various City departments/divisions. (Inspection fee shall be bid on a per unit basis; however, the charge shall not be allowed when the unit requires recharging at the time of inspection.)
13. Vendor must furnish a semi-annual Excel spreadsheet, which shall include the Department Location, Building Name, Address, Square Footage, Extinguisher Types, Last Date Serviced and Extinguisher Expiration date.
14. The City reserves the right to add or delete locations contained within this bid via written amendment.
15. Successful Vendor shall provide a one (1) year warranty after the equipment has been serviced by the Successful Vendor.

## SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of January, 2017, by and between the City of Plant City ("City") and \_\_\_\_\_ ("Company"), whose address is \_\_\_\_\_.

WHEREAS, City desires to retain Company to perform required fire extinguisher service on all fire extinguisher systems for various departments and divisions of the City, as described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Company represents that Company is qualified, willing and able to provide the described services according to the terms of this Agreement; it is therefore agreed that:

1. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT. The parties agree that the purpose of this Agreement is for the Company to perform required fire extinguisher service on all fire extinguisher systems for various departments and divisions of the City as described in the Invitation to Bid No. 17-012 GS-ME for the fees and charges as described in its submitted Company's Bid Form. The Scope of Services in the Invitation to Bid and the rates and charges as described in the Company's Bid Form are attached as Exhibits A and B respectively. The locations where services are to be performed are attached as Exhibit C. The terms of the Invitation to Bid and Company's Bid Form are incorporated herein by this reference. **Notwithstanding, no deviations in the Company's Executed Bid Form from the Invitation to Bid or other Contract documents prepared by the City shall be incorporated herein unless expressly provided in this Contract. Any conflict with the Company's Bid Form and the Invitation to Bid and other contract documents prepared by the City shall be construed in favor of the contract documents prepared by the City.**

2. COMMENCEMENT AND TERM. The contract will commence on January 15, 2017 and shall terminate on January 14, 2018, unless extended by mutual agreement of the parties or terminated as provided in paragraph 4 herein. Contract extensions may be approved by the City Manager for four (4) additional one-year periods under the same terms and conditions.

3. PAYMENTS TO COMPANY. All payments shall be made on a monthly basis within thirty (30) days after receipt of invoice(s) that shall conform to the City's accounting submittal requirements. Upon certification by the City Manager that all work has been performed in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the City Manager will authorize payment of such invoice(s).

4. TERMINATION.

A. If the City materially breaches this Agreement, the Company may terminate the Agreement and shall thereafter be entitled only to compensation for services actually performed hereunder prior to such breach. Company expressly waives any and all

other claims and remedies against the City, including incidental and consequential damages. Company shall give written notice to the City of any alleged breach and the City shall have ten (10) days from the date of such notice in which to cure the breach before Company may proceed under this paragraph.

B. If the Company materially breaches this Agreement, the City may terminate the Agreement and shall thereafter have available to it all rights and remedies in law and equity, the exercise of which shall be cumulative rather than exclusive. The City shall give written notice to the Company of any alleged breach and the Company shall have ten (10) days from the date of such notice to cure the breach before the City may proceed under this paragraph.

C. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, the City may terminate this Agreement without regard to cause at any time with thirty (30) days' notice to Company, provided that in such event, the City shall pay compensation for services actually performed hereunder prior to such termination.

5. NO MINIMUM AMOUNT OF WORK. This Agreement is non-exclusive. Notwithstanding any provision in this Agreement, City shall not be obligated to assign any minimum amount of Work to Company during the term of this Agreement. Company shall have no claim against City for damages or loss of profits due to the amount of Work assigned under this Agreement.

6. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS OF SERVICES. The City reserves the right to add any locations or delete any locations at any time without cause. If such right is exercised, the total fee shall be increased or reduced by the amount established for that service. If work has already been accomplished on the portion of the contract to be deleted, the Company shall be paid for the deleted portion on the basis of the percentage of completion.

7. SECURITY. Some locations will have designated City staff available to provide entry to and exit from facilities. Other locations may require the Company to gain entry using established alarm procedures or by using keys/striker cards. Company's employees must be properly identified and will not be permitted to enter or leave buildings at will once reporting to duty. Under no circumstances shall Company, or its agents or employees, provide access to any unauthorized person in the City's facilities.

8. COMPANY'S PERSONNEL. Company is to have all Company's employees doing work under this Agreement bonded. The City reserves the right to request background and bonding information for all personnel assigned to this contract.

9. PROFESSIONAL APPEARANCE. Company's employees assigned to this contract are to present a professional appearance, shall be neat, clean, well-groomed, courteous, and properly dressed and shall conduct themselves in a respectable manner while performing duties and while on City property. Company's employees assigned to this contract shall wear a name tag specifying the name of the employee and the Company's company name.

10. SUPERVISION. Company shall provide supervision of its employees during all service hours. If any work is unsatisfactory, the Company will be contacted and any discrepancies corrected at no additional cost to the City. Continued unsatisfactory work may result in termination of this agreement.

Company shall provide the emergency telephone numbers of supervisory personnel assigned to the contract.

11. WARRANTY AND STANDARD OF CARE. Since City has entrusted this work to Company, Company shall use its professional expertise to protect the interests of the City at all times with regard to its performance under this Agreement. Company shall assume towards City a professional relationship of trust, confidence and fair dealing.

Company hereby warrants that it is competent to perform the tasks undertaken, that the product of such services shall be consistent with the requirements stated herein and with prevailing industry standards, and that all work strictly complies with the requirements of this Contract. Any work not strictly complying with the requirements of this Paragraph shall constitute a breach of the Company's warranty.

12. DEDUCTIONS TO INVOICES. In the event the Company shall not have completed all of the required or monthly services as scheduled and outlined in the services required specifications, the Company will be required to make corrections of all discrepancies during the following scheduled work day. These corrections must be completely performed in accordance with the specifications requirements. If they are not, a deduction of the total daily cost for that location will be subtracted from the Company's monthly invoice. Failure of the Company to appear on any scheduled workday shall result in the deduction of the total daily cost for that location.

13. WAIVER AND MODIFICATION CLAUSE. Any waiver, modification or cancellation of any term or condition of this Agreement, including but not limited to changes in the services to be performed by the Company pursuant to the Invitation to Bid and Bidder Proposal Form an increases or decreases in the Company's compensation, must be agreed to in writing and signed by both parties in order to be effective.

14. CONSTRUCTION. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws, rules and regulations of the State of Florida.

15. INSURANCE. The Company shall furnish proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance, and General Liability. Coverage to remain in force at all times during the contract period. The Company shall have the City named as additional insured under the existing insurance policy. The following minimum insurance coverage is required:

- (a) Workers' Compensation: Statutory amount.
- (b) Employer's Liability: \$500,000.

- (c) Commercial General Liability (Combined bodily injury/property damage):  
\$1,000,000.

The City reserves the right to require the Company to furnish satisfactory evidence of the above protection before work is started or at any time thereafter.

16. INDEMNIFICATION. The Company shall be liable for, and shall indemnify, defend and hold the City harmless from all claims, suits, judgments or damages, including court costs and reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of the Company's errors, omissions or negligent acts of the Company, its agents and employees, in performance of this Agreement.

17. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. The services performed by Company shall be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, including Florida's Sunshine law and Florida's Public Records law.

18. PERMITS, FEES, TAXES, LICENSES. Company shall, at his own expense, obtain all necessary permits, pay all licenses, fees and taxes required to comply with all local ordinances, State and Federal laws, rules and regulations applicable under this Agreement. This provision also includes the City issued permits.

19. OSHA REQUIREMENTS. Company agrees to comply with the provisions of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, and the standards and regulations issued thereunder, and warrants that all services furnished under this agreement will conform to and comply with said standards and regulations. Company agrees to furnish Material Safety Data Sheets (for OSHA020) as applicable for hazardous or potentially hazardous products.

20. STATEMENT OF ASSURANCE. During the performance of this Agreement, the Company assures the City that Company is in compliance with Title VII of the 1964 Civil Rights Act, as amended, and the Florida Human Rights Act of 1977; that Company does not on the grounds of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, handicap or marital status, discriminate in any form or manner against Company's employees or applicants for employment. This Agreement is expressly conditioned upon the veracity of this Statement of Assurance and the Company's compliance with Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 when federal grant(s) is/are involved. Other applicable Federal and State laws, Executive Orders and regulations prohibiting such discrimination are also included by this reference. This Statement of Assurance shall be interpreted to include Vietnam-Era Veterans and Disabled Veterans within its protective range of applicability.

21. PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES. In accordance with Section 287.133, Florida Statutes, any person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid, proposal or reply on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid, proposal, or reply on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or

public work, may not submit bids, proposals or replies on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor or consultant under a contract with a public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity of the threshold amount provided in Section 218.017, Florida Statutes, for CATEGORY TWO for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

By execution of this Agreement, Company assures the City that none of its officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members or any of its agents who are active in management have been convicted of a public entity crime. In the event that any of its officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members or any of its agents who are active in management are convicted of a public entity crime, the Company shall immediately notify the City.

22. NON-WAIVER. No failure by the City to insist upon the strict performance of any term or condition of this Agreement or to exercise any right or remedy available upon a breach hereof, shall constitute a waiver of any such breach or of any such term or condition. No waiver of any breach shall affect or alter any term or condition in this Agreement, and each such term or condition shall continue in full force and effect with respect to any other then existing or subsequent breach thereof.

23. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES. Nothing contained in this contract shall be deemed or construed to the relationship between the parties of principal and agent, or of partnership or joint venture, or of employer and employee; it being expressly agreed that the relationship of the Company to the City is that of an independent contractor.

24. VENUE. Venue for any action to enforce this Agreement shall be Hillsborough County, Florida.

25. PUBLIC RECORDS.

30. CAPTIONS. All titles to clauses contained in this Agreement are for identification only and shall not be construed as being a substantive part of the Agreement.
